Dear Neighbour,

New Buildings Solar Farm Ltd. will shortly be bringing forward a proposal for a Solar Farm located on parcels of land located at New Buildings Farm, Cresswell Road, Stone, ST15 8SL. The site lies to the north-east of the settlement of Stone and consists of small to medium sized agricultural fields.

The proposed development will generate approximately 40 Megawatts (MW) of clean, renewable energy. This will make a vital contribution to climate change targets and the country's transition away from fossil fuels.

The development has several key benefits, including but not limited to:

- Generating clean renewable energy to help Staffordshire Moorlands District Council and East Staffordshire Borough Council meet its target of net zero carbon emissions by 2030.
- No agricultural land will be lost as the solar farm will be designed to allow livestock to graze under and around the panels during operation, providing a dual benefit of agriculture and energy generation.
- An increased setback from the Bromley Wood and planting of additional hedgerows and trees. The site is unlikely to be visible from the settlement of Stone and Draycott in the Moors, or from the properties along Cresswell Road.
